Cooper Farms Tree Replacement Program

We have finished Year 2 of the 5 year tree replacement program. You can check out where you are in the process by looking at our website at this link

If you are in **Year 2** of the program, you should have a water bag on your tree.

If you were in **Year 1**, you now own that tree. It does not belong to Cooper Farms and you are responsible for the tree, just like any other tree on your property. If the tree dies after the first year it is the homeowner's responsibility to have it removed and replaced.

There will be new pool furniture for the 2019 season!



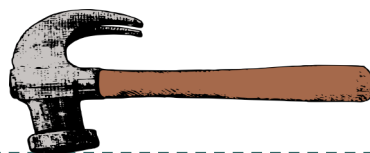
